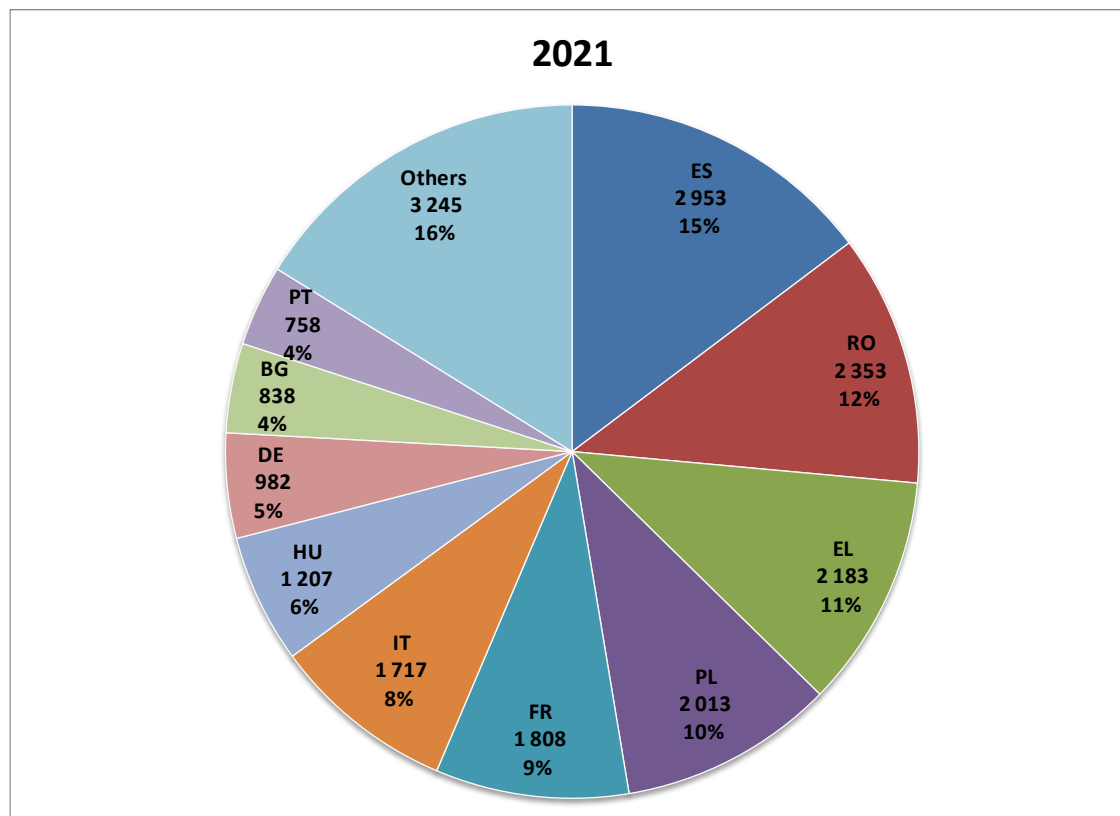


# Number (in thousand) and share of beehives per MS in 2021

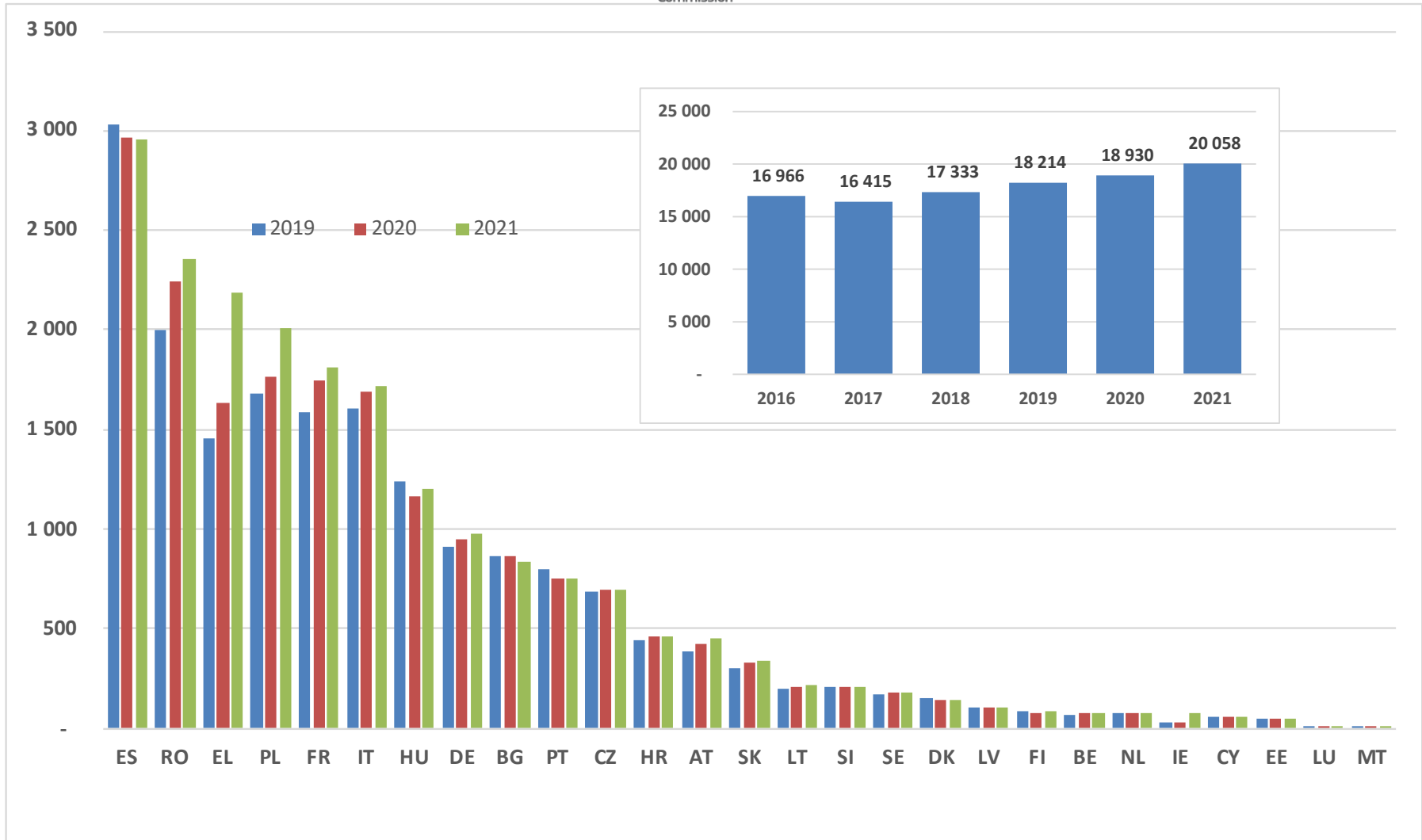

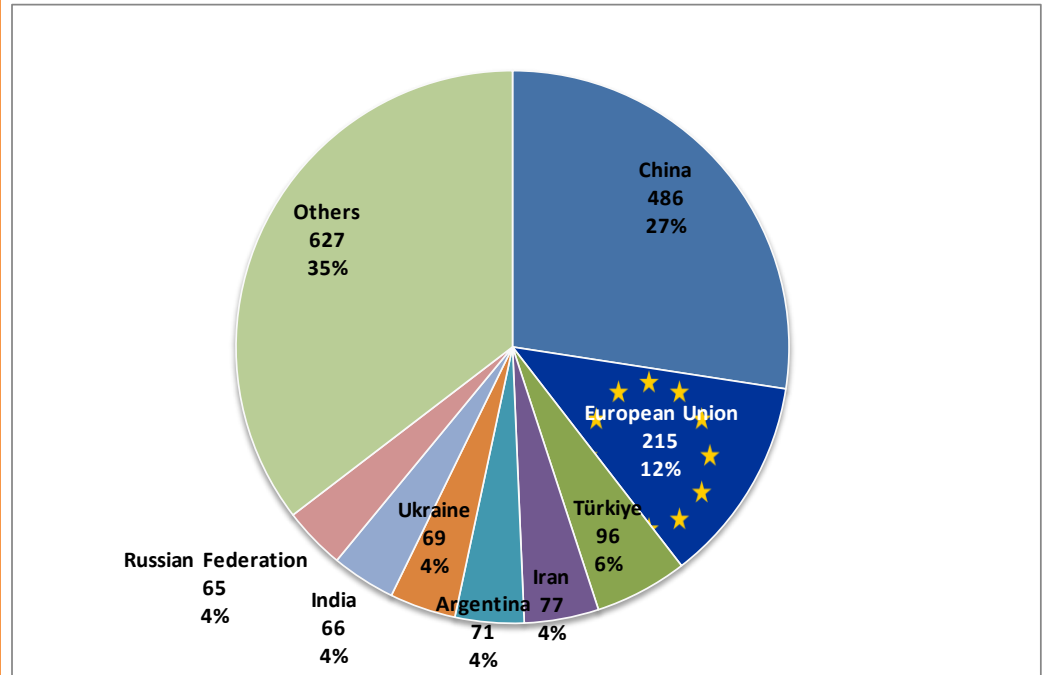


# Evolution of the number of hives (in thousand)

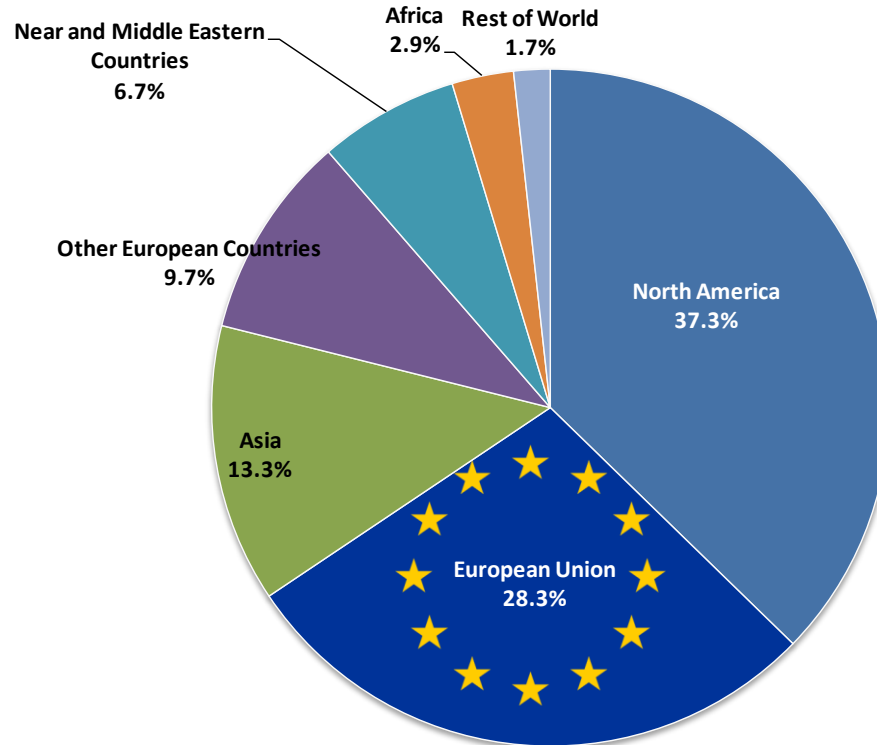

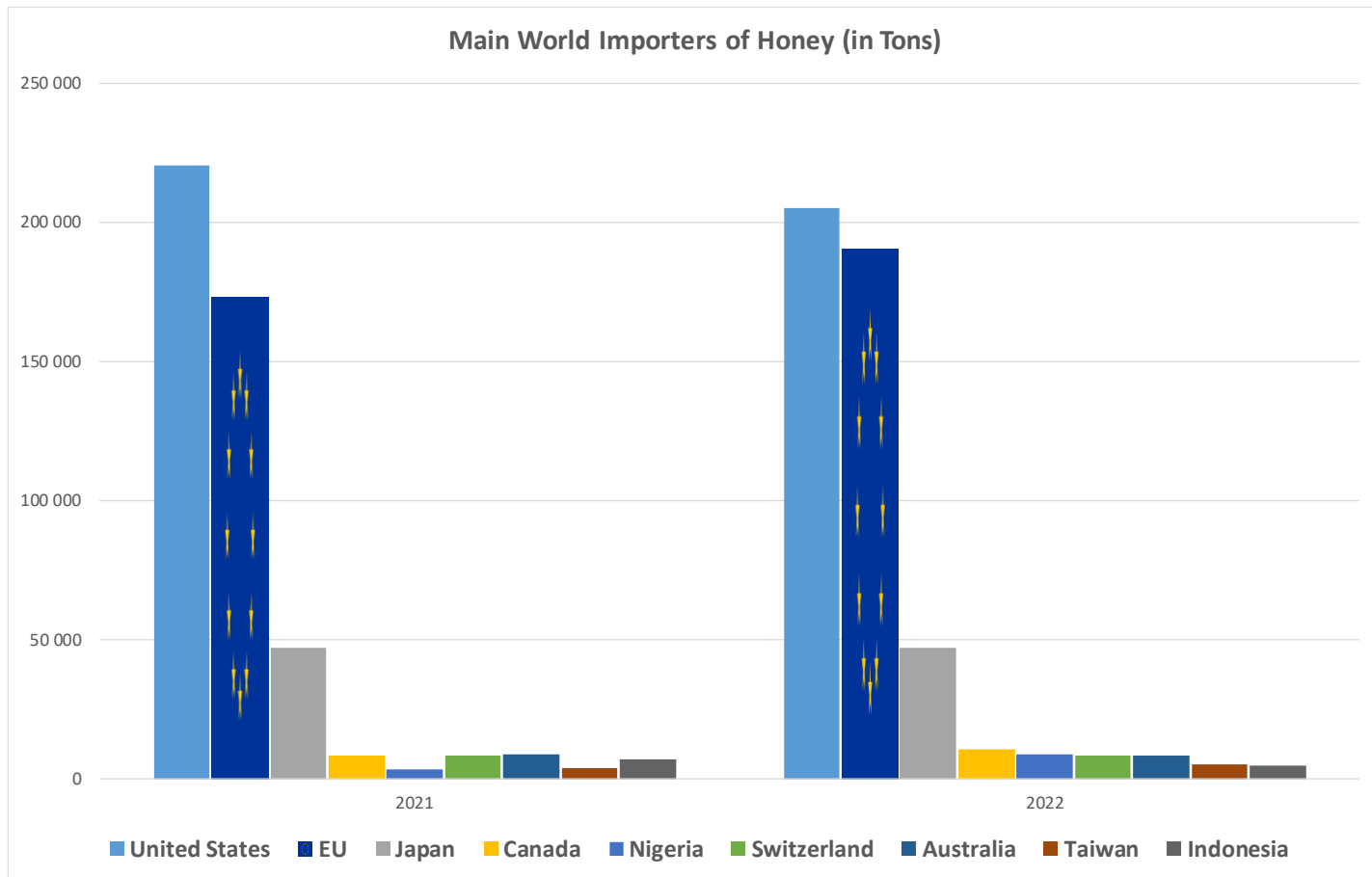

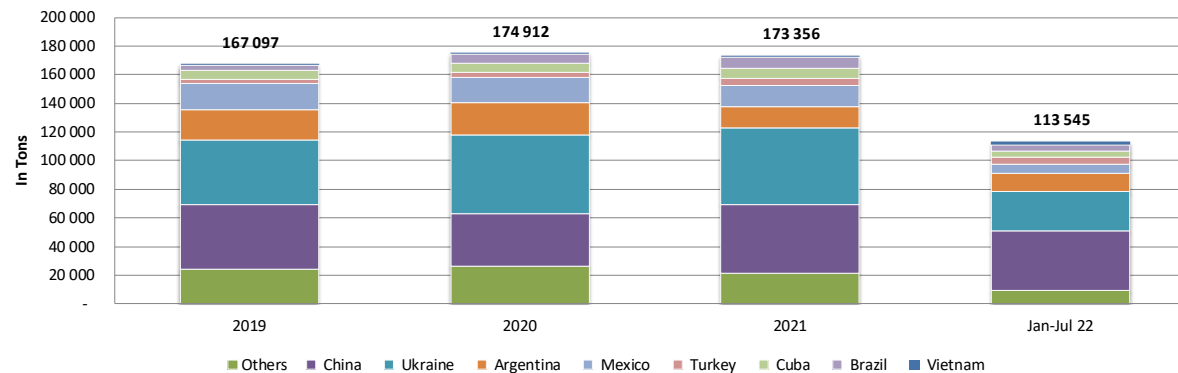
# Main World Importers of Honey (2022/2021)

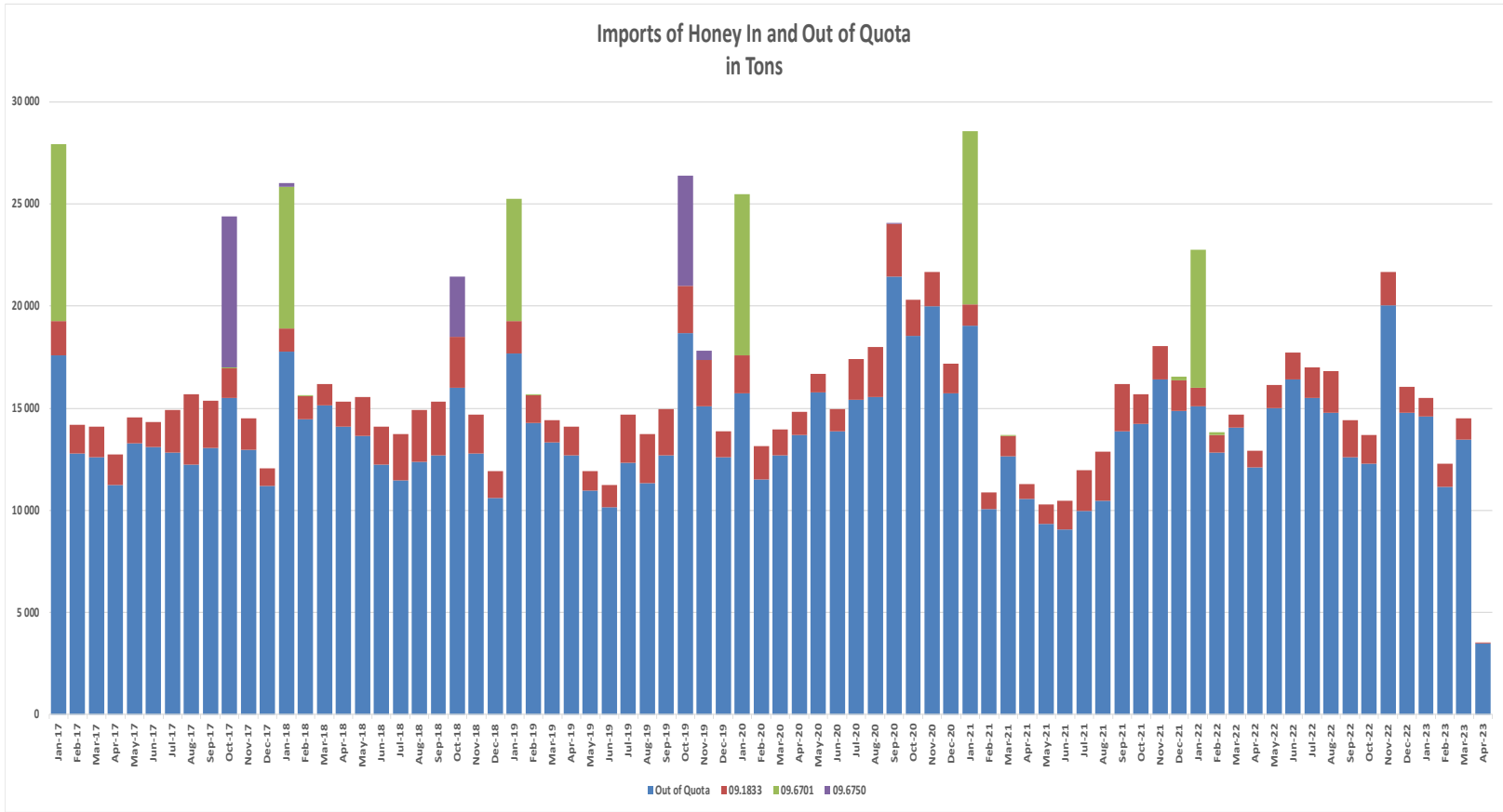

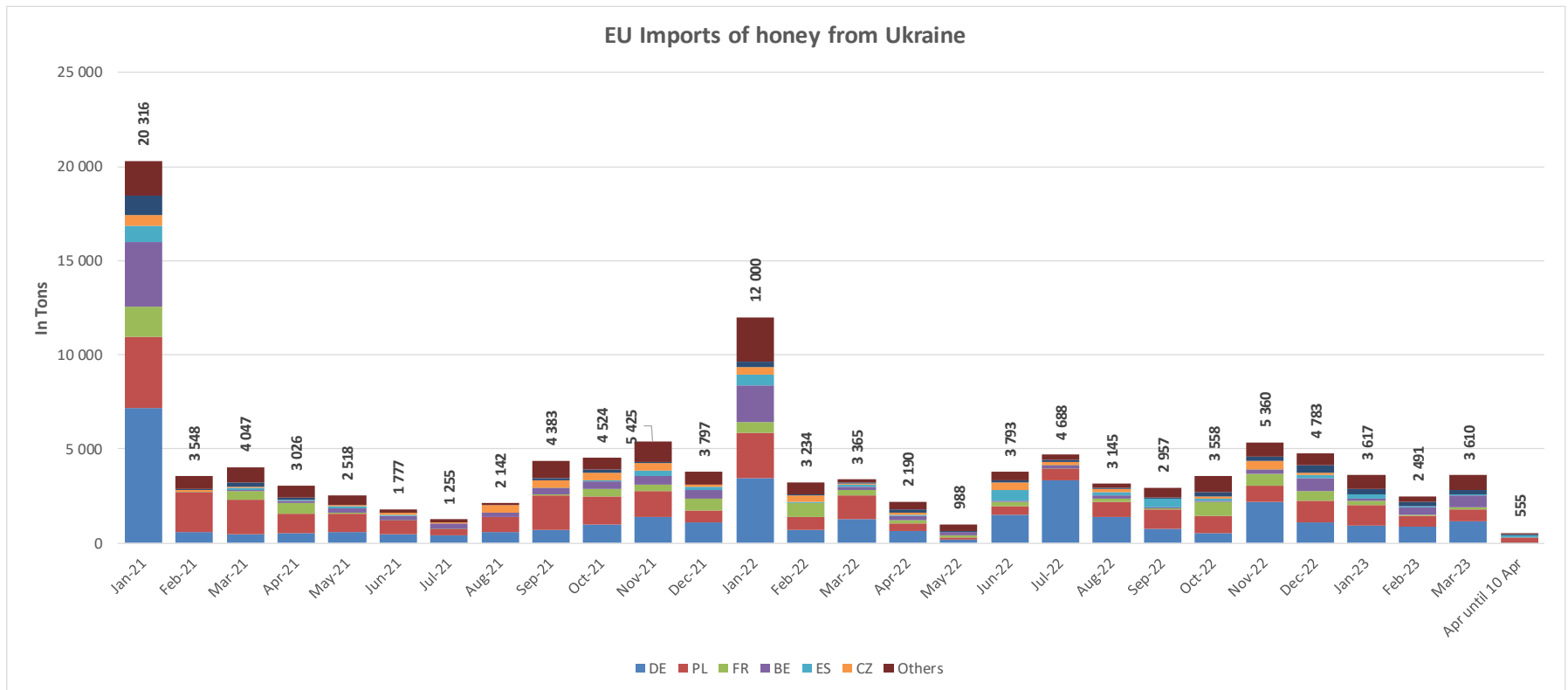

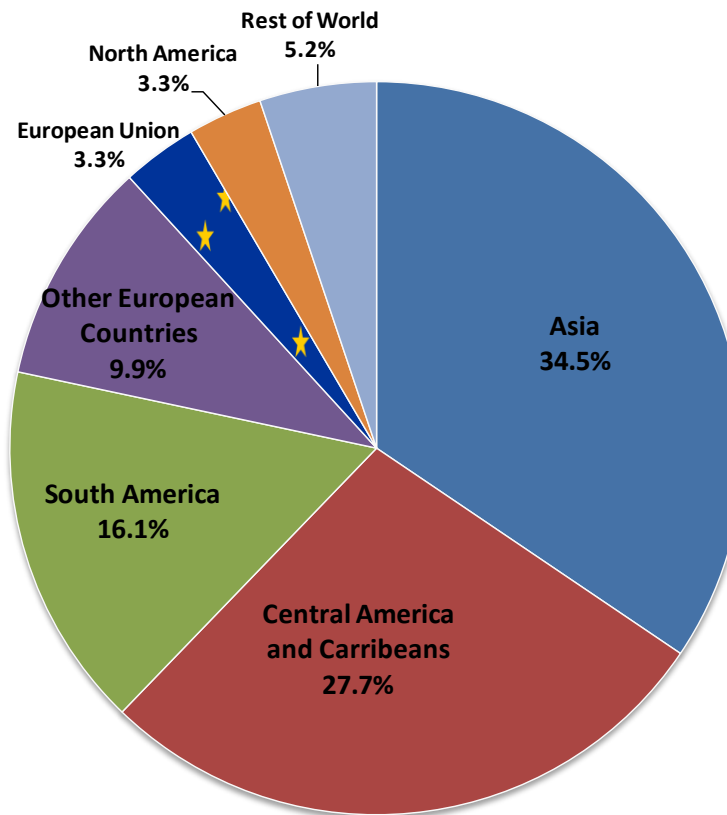

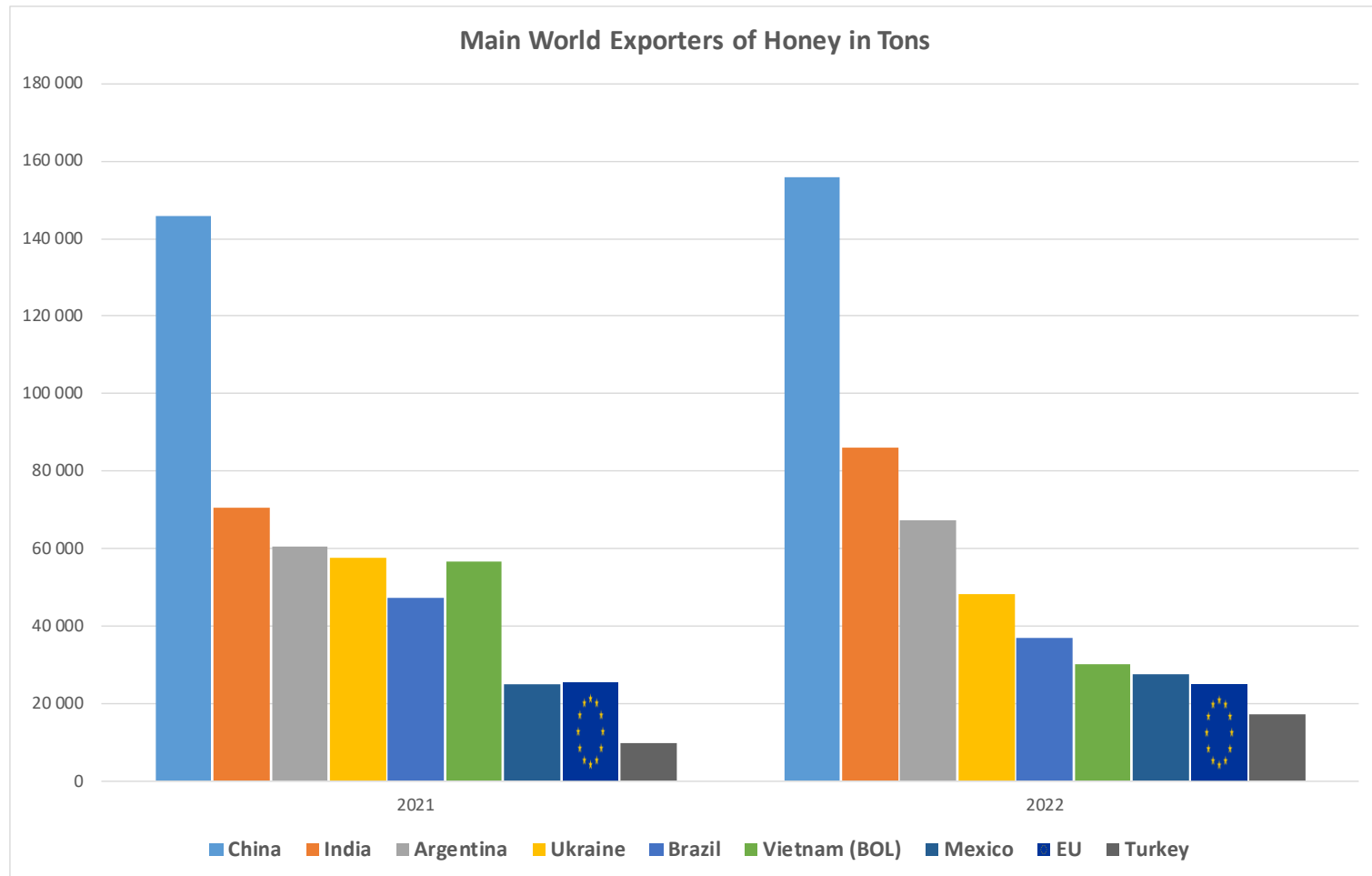


# The World's Honey exporters (2021)

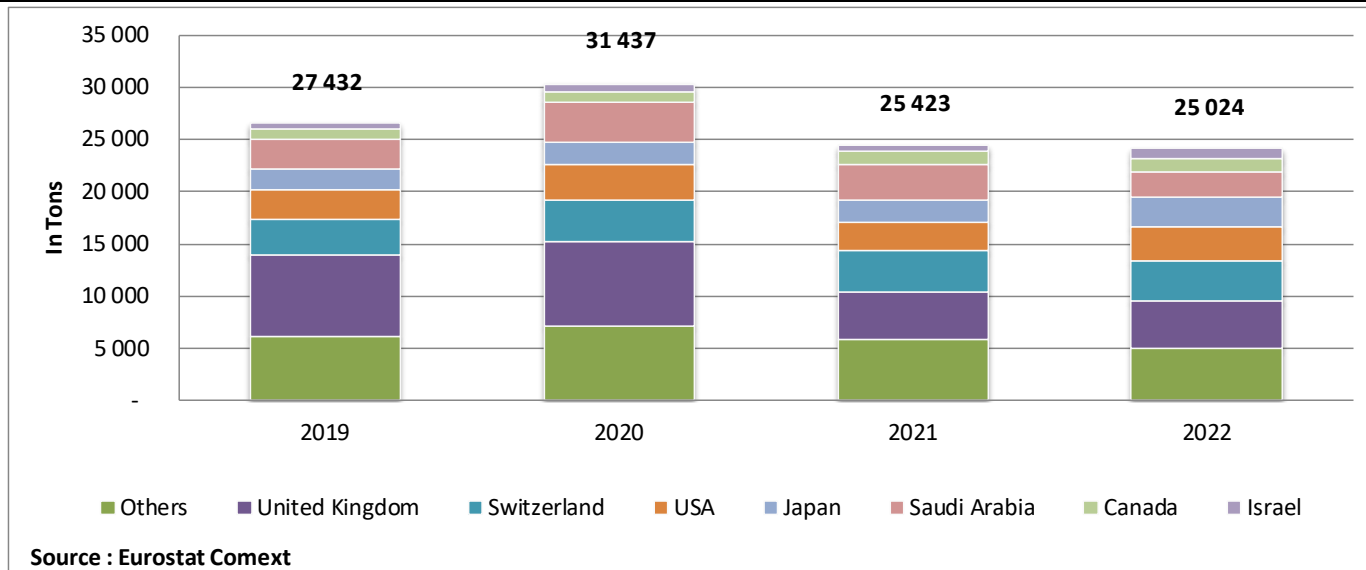
# Main World Exporters of Honey (2022)

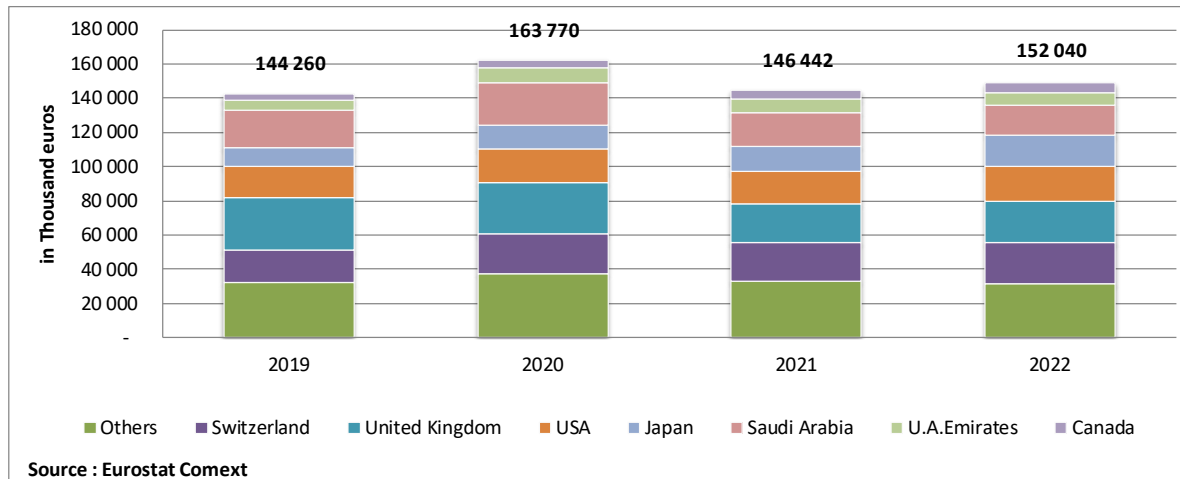

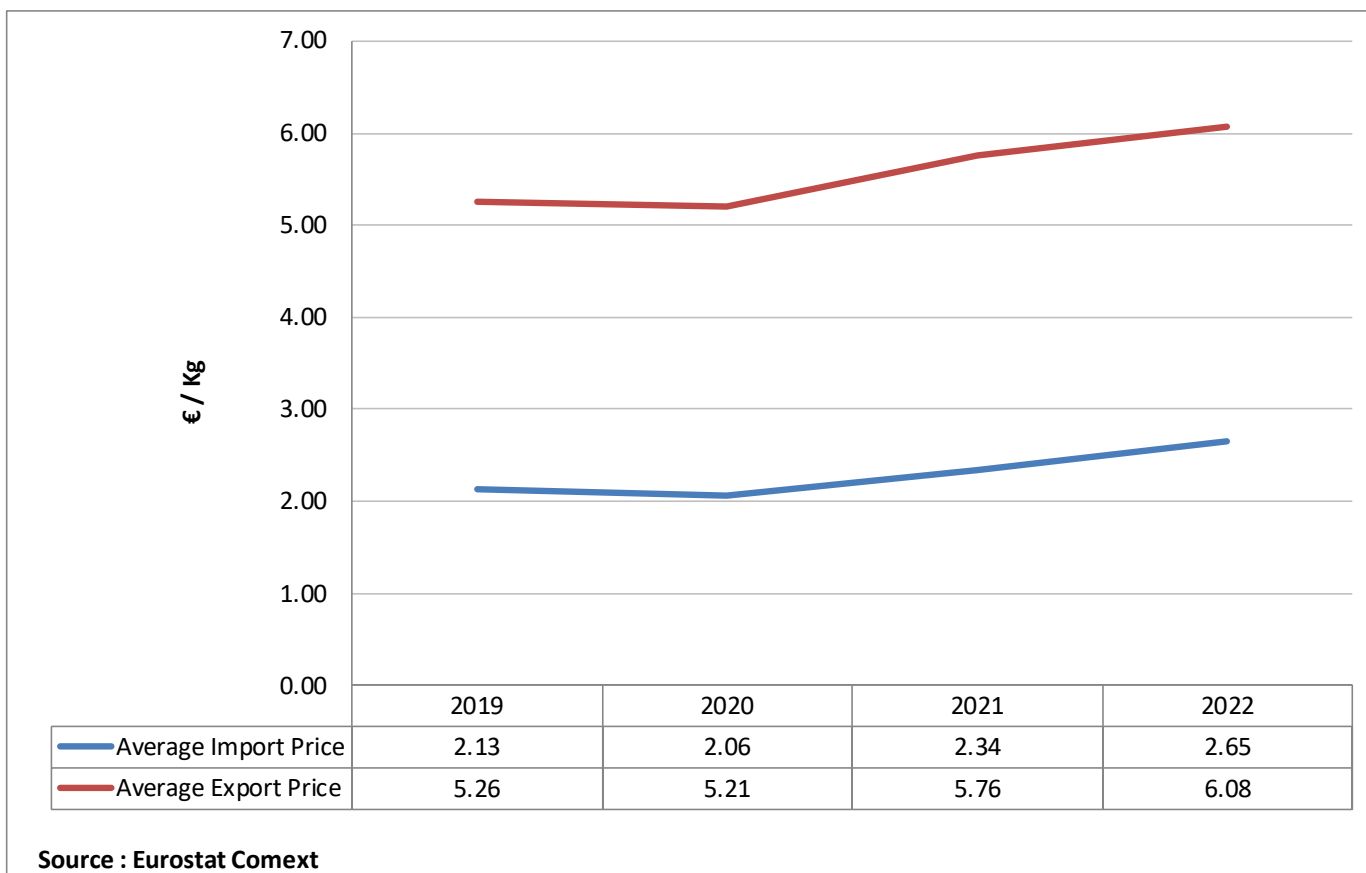

# Import and Export Unit Values



## Summary of EU honey market situation (1)

- EU remains second world producer (~215 000 tons, 2021) after China
- Total number of beehives keeps increasing (20 millions, 2021) while honey production lagging behind
- Small sector but essential for agriculture for pollinisation





## Summary of EU honey market situation (2)

- EU only 60% self-sufficient in honey
- Imports needed to cover EU domestic consumption
- China and Ukraine remain key suppliers
- EU honey trade balance keeps largely negative: Imports > Exports
- Both import and export prices increasing, while import prices remain at comparatively low level
